Joining the CAC gives you an opportunity to have your opinions heard and to make a difference in the way Special Education is conducted in Elk Grove.

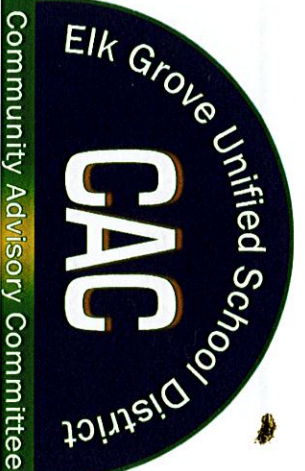
